

## Barrow Haven to New Holland

From Barrow Haven railway station cross the level crossing heading north and take the public right of way, to the right of the green gates next to Watch House, and cross the Old Ferry Wharf timber yard.



You are soon on the banks of the Humber Estuary, don't forget to look behind you for stunning views of the Humber Bridge!



Follow the path for about two miles with more views on either side of the waterways and natural bird and wildlife habitats.



Pass the Humber Bulk Terminal, once the New Holland Dock, where the ferry from Hull used to dock, and follow the path around the side of the Arborforest factory.



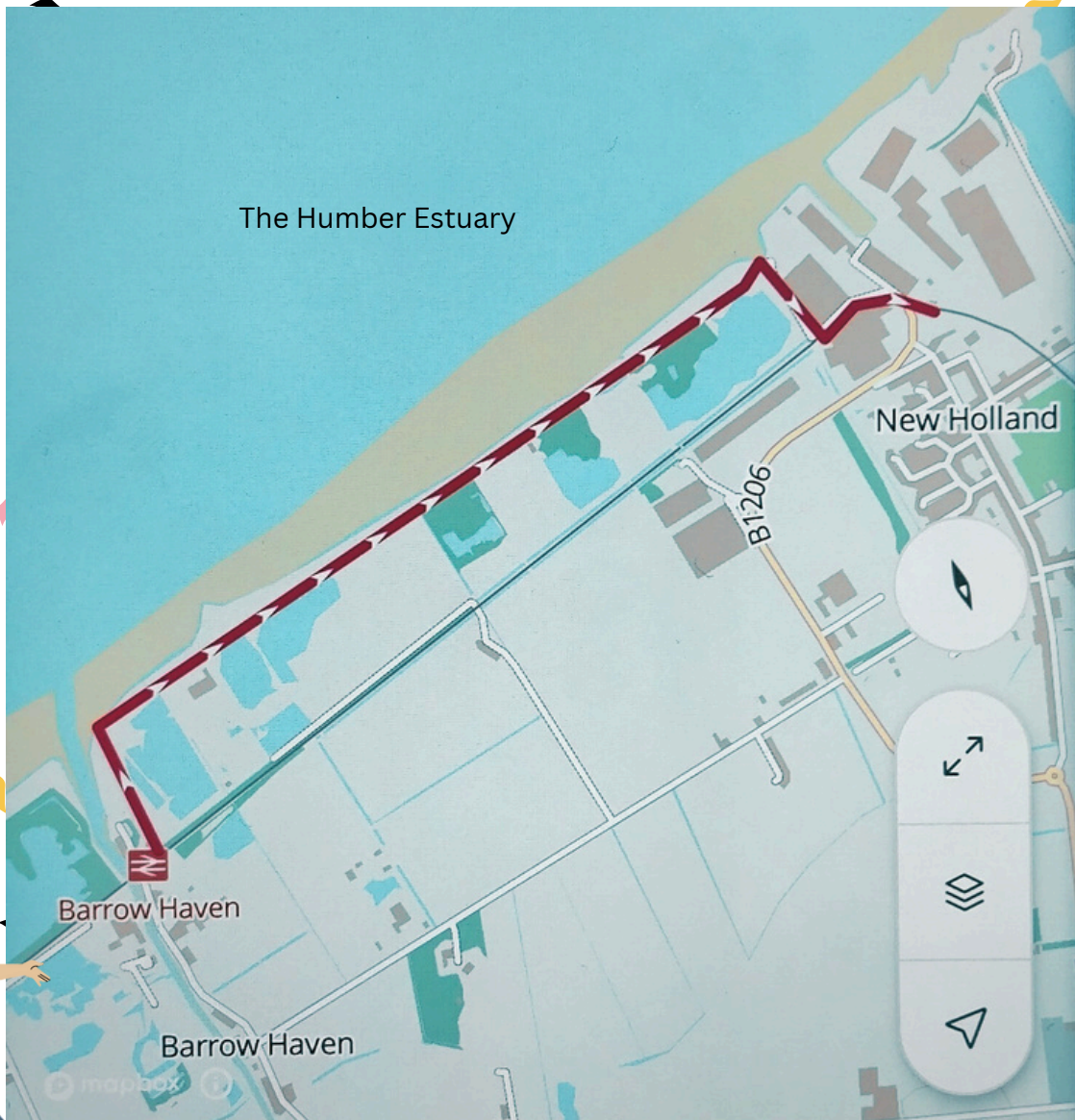
You will see the train track on your right. Pass the signal box, cross the level crossing and arrive at New Holland railway station.
