

New Clew to Cleethorpes



Starting at Clee Railway Station head south along Thorold Street keeping the railway on your left.



After ten minutes Thorold Street becomes Harrington Street and to your right you pass Blundell Park, the home ground of Grimsby Town Football Club.

At the end of the street turn right onto Manchester Street then take the first left onto Oliver Street and continue to the end. Turn left and go over the blue and yellow footbridge which leads to the promenade, with sweeping views of the beach and Humber Estuary out to the North Sea.

Continue along the promenade passing the iconic metal sculpture, Blackrow Globe, and then the fairground with the pier in the distance.



You will see the entrance to Cleethorpes railway station on the right next to the fish and chip shop!

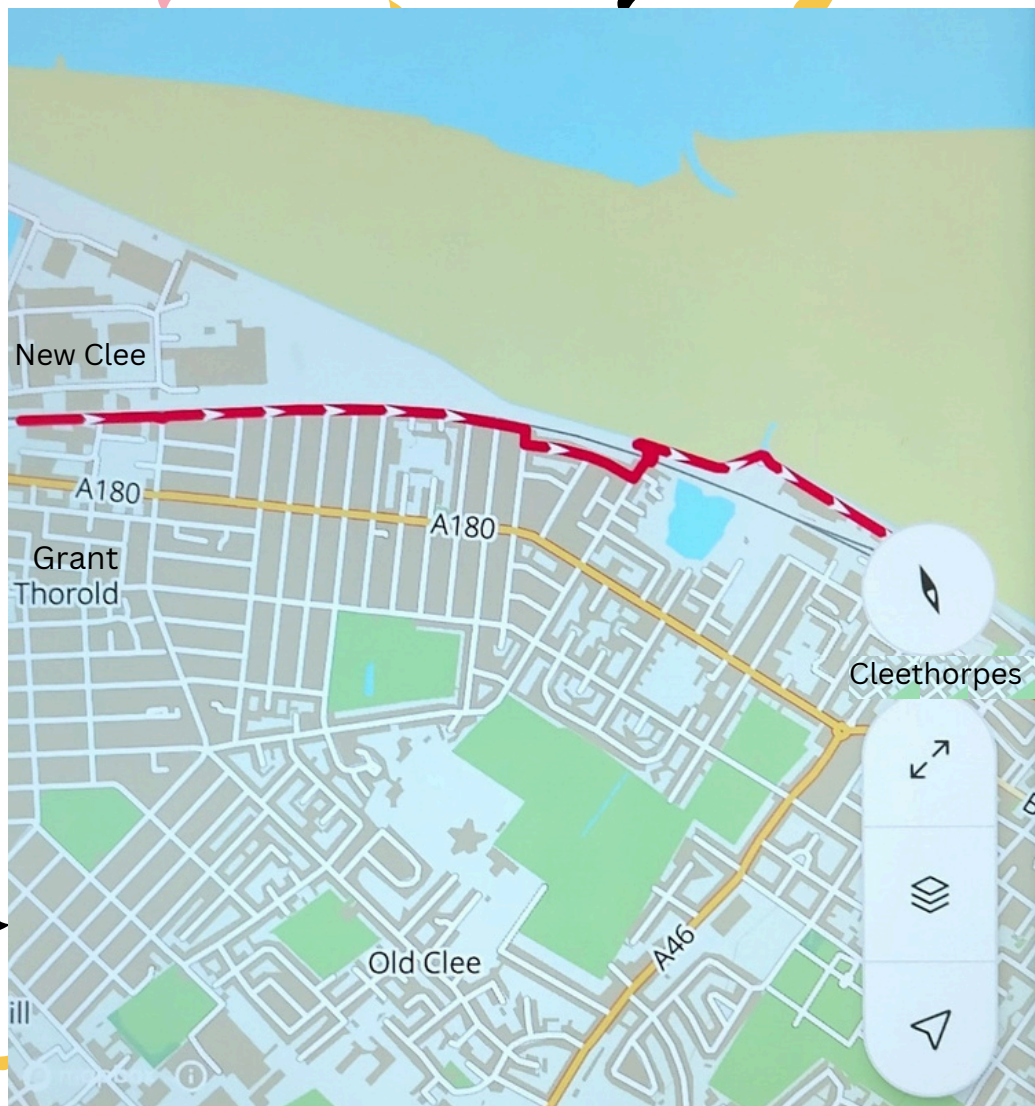
